The Museum's collections span continents and time, giving a glimpse into the development of ceramic processes, decoration and form. Year-round, the Museum mounts special exhibitions, events, lectures and clay classes to complement its permanent collection. DESCRIPTION OF EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMS

We offer a wide variety of hand-on, curriculum linked education programs at the Gardiner. Each program gives the students an opportunity to explore the museums permanent collections or special exhibits followed by an opportunity to work in our studios with a professional ceramic artist. Here the students will hand build sculptures with the guidance of the artists that reflect the program of choice. This program is available as a half day (1 1/2 to 2 hours) or as a full day (4 hours, for kids in grade 3 and up). Both full day and half day allow the students to work in clay.
