Discover the connections between cultures and across time at the Aga Khan Museum, North America's first museum dedicated to the arts of Muslim civilizations. Set within a landscaped park, the Museum is a stunning home to historical and contemporary exhibitions, live arts and film programming, an exquisite Permanent Collection, and a vibrant educational program that reveals numerous links to the Ontario Curriculum.

PERFORMANCE SITE DESCRIPTION

Your students will have an unforgettable experience performing at the Aga Khan Museum. Designed by world-renowned Japanese architect Fumihiko Maki and inspired by the concept of light, the Museum is one of the city's most unique spaces to host all manner of music, dance, drama, and choir performances. Three interior performance spaces are available: the open-roofed courtyard with 13-metre-tall glass walls; the beautiful atrium, filled with patterned light; and the 340-seat auditorium, an architectural highlight of the Museum. In warm weather, the formal garden of the Aga Khan Park — featuring five reflecting pools — is an inviting exterior space for performances of all kinds.
