YOUNG PEOPLE'S THEATRE (YPT) is the oldest professional theatre company in Toronto and is a national producer and presenter of theatre for young audiences - the first and largest of its kind in Canada. Over the past 52 years YPT has staged many of the most important plays that form the canon of work for youth in our country. The enriched learning experiences of YPT's Education & Participation Department also provide young people with opportunities to develop their whole being. At Young People's Theatre we strive for a positive and lasting impact on the emotional, social, and intellectual development of young people - giving them the chance to grow into the unique and wonderful people they were born to be.

DESCRIPTION OF EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMS

Our 2017/18 theatre season features two beloved children's classic stories adapted for the stage: YPT's production of Disney's Beauty and the Beast (SK-Grade 6), and the play The Secret Garden (Grades 1-6). Other productions include Risky Phil (Grades 4-8) a the new comedy about fathers and sons, Bello (SK-5) a fantastical fable about facing fears, Salmon Girl (SK-5), a beautiful Indigenous dance-drama, Instant (Grades 7-12) which explores identity and fame via social media, and Selfie (Grades 8-12) a powerful, timely play that delves into sexual consent and social media. Performances include FREE facilitated post-show Q & A sessions with members of the cast. (Not applicable for preview performances.) YPT also offers pre-show and post-show Companion Workshops.
